### **Camping Rules & Regulations**

#### **For Campers**

- 1) No expensive items such as gold rings, necklaces, computer games, hand- phone, MP3 players, etc be brought inside the camp.
- 2) Participate all activities during the camp.
- 3) Must be punctual in all activities.
- 4) Must be clean and hygiene at all times.
- 5) Listen and obey commands from the Officers/Captain/Chaplain.
- 6) Cannot leave the camp site once started , except in emergency cases approved by the Captain or Chaplain.
- 7) Observed all rules and regulation during the camp.

#### **For Parents/ Guardians**

- 1) No parent/guardian is allowed inside the campsite once it has started. The Park gate will be closed after 7.00pm.
- 2) Campers are to gather in the Church on the 15 March 2009(Sunday) at 1.00pm and will depart to the camp site by 2.00pm.
- 3) Parents/Guardians are to collect their child on the 18 March 2009 (Wednesday) at approximately 5.00-6.00pm from the Church.
- 4) Ensure all overnight camping gears are packed and carried by the child to the camp. Name-tagged all items brought in by the child.
- 5) You can call or sms to the child's respective Officers to check the status of your child during the camp but not allowed to talk to the child.
- 6) The respective Officers will notify you if there is an emergency only.
- 7) Campers are to cook by themselves all the meals in the camp and parents/guardians are encouraged to contribute food items based on the camp menus. Kindly notify the Officer in-charge if you wish to contribute some food for the camp .

#### **Overnight Camping Gears**

- 1) Sleeping bag
- 2) Mattress or foam sleeping pad.
- 3) Extra clothing , swim wear, slippers, shorts.
- 4) Undergarments.
- 5) Pajamas or wind breaker with jacket and long pants.
- 6) Toiletries such as toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, towel, comb, mosquito repellent, myopic oilment.
- 7) BB mufti & coy t-shirt, & gears for drill practices.
